1. Charlie Blair – Waltham Forest Giving

Waltham Forest Giving raises and distributes funds and resources to help local organisations support the communities in the borough. It is an independent initiative, hosted by Groundwork London which connects and enthuses local people and businesses to address local needs. It is led by a steering group of residents who are designing the scheme and forms part of a wider network of 18 giving schemes in London. Working with partners to support the community to access leisure centres and introduce community initiatives and activities to get more people active.

Mission is to provide safe and creative spaces for children and their adults to play, learn and interact and loan high quality toys. Their aim is to reduce toy waste and encourage reuse and recycling.


Attendees were encouraged to focus on an idea from the previous workshop and form into groups to discuss the idea further.

Each group were encouraged to identify:


- Why do we need this service


Group 1 – Painting Together
